



auricio Di Bartolomeo is the Co-Founder & Chief Strategy Officer at Ledn Inc., a financial services company built for Bitcoin and digital assets. The company underwrote Canada's first-ever Bitcoin-backed loan in 2018, and most recently announced the world's first Bitcoin-backed mortgage. It also offers a full suite of lending, savings, and trading products, providing financial services to digital asset holders in over 127 countries. Mauricio has been involved in Bitcoin since 2014, when in Venezuela he learned that his family and friends were using it to earn an income by mining it and protecting their wealth by converting it into a censorship-resistance currency. Now residing in Canada, he has been working on Bitcoin full-time since then, developing technology to make it easier to hold and use. Ledn powers savings and lending products that unlock the potential of digital assets. Mauricio is a graduate of the HBA and MBA programs at the Richard Ivey School of Business and authors Ledn's weekly research letter, The Bitcoin Economic Calendar, which goes out to over 100,000 subscribers weekly.


oe Gorman is the Director of Public Affairs at Humber River Hospital. Joe was born in Newmarket and grew up in a large family, who instilled a passion for community and togetherness from a young age. Joe served as the Director of Columbus Boys Camp for eight years and provided underprivileged boys with positive and supportive experiences. His compassionate spirit and innate ability to connect with people led to his Board membership with Inn from the Cold and Rose of Sharon to support and come alongside the underserved, including young single mothers.

Joe is well known within the Greater Toronto Area for his generosity and inviting leadership. Joe served his community as a Catholic priest from 2008 to 2015, and during that time was an appreciated leader, who fostered a meaningful and impactful sense of community among his congregations. Applying his desire to influence positive change to a different setting, he began working in public affairs and has continuously found ways to help those who need it most through this role.

Joe's philanthropic and generous mindset led to integrating his longstanding community work with various campaigns and initiatives at Humber. He was critical to the inception of vaccination clinics in the Northwest Toronto community - one of the hardest-hit areas by COVID-19 - which vaccinated over 400,000 people. 


